1. Funding for local roads in Benzie County. John Rothhaar prepared a summary of how local roads are funded, and presented the question of how the Road Commission will be using the additional money they are going to receive from the increased gas tax. It was suggested that if all Township Supervisors were in agreement with a proposal to present to the Road Commission that they consider going back to past practice of a 50/50 cost share, or at least some cost share of local road improvements than Townships could afford the upkeep needed on their local roads.
