


Good Neighbor Guide

Parking – Please use your rental's off-street parking spaces and do not park on or block the improved part of any public street or road, including the shoulders.



Garbage – Your host/landlord will provide instructions for trash pick-up. All garbage must be in properly secured containers out of public sight. Unsecured garbage is unsightly and can attract unwanted wildlife, including skunks, racoons, and bears.



Recycling – Benzie County maintains single-stream recycling bins at various locations including in Honor, Beulah, Frankfort, and Benzonia.

Outdoor Lighting – Lake Township has a lighting ordinance to reduce light pollution and shield neighboring property. Spotlights can be particularly intrusive and must not be directed at neighboring property and must be shut off by 11:00 PM.

<u>Fireworks</u> – Except for the following dates and times, consumer fireworks may not be used in Lake Township. Fireworks may be used only to celebrate the following holidays:

- ✓ New Year's Eve from 11:00 AM on New Year's Eve until 1:00 AM on January 1st.
- Memorial Day from 11:00 AM until 11:45 PM on the Saturday and Sunday proceeding Memorial Day.
- ✓ Fourth of July from 11:00 AM until 11:45 PM on any of the following dates: June 29, and 30, and July 1, 2, 3, and 4; and in addition, on July 5, but only if it falls on a Friday or Saturday.
- ✓ Labor Day from 11:00 AM until 11:45 PM on the Saturday and Sunday preceding Labor Day
